 Williams of the county of Edge City and

 but of perfect mind and memory do make
 constitute and ordain this my last
 will and Testament —

I Give unto my loving wife
 Annary Williams the whole of my
 Estate both real and personal
 during her life, or Widowhood;
 And in case that my Wife should
 marry — I then gave the whole of my
 Estate to my Daughter Mary Williams
 to be kept together for her support
 untill she comes to lawful age or marries

And if my said Daughter should
 die before she comes of age or marries
 I then give the whole of my Estate to
 my loving Wife —

And it is my further Will & desire
 that if my said Wife should die
 before my said Daughter is of
 age or if my said Daughter should die
 before she comes of age or marries —

Then that my Estate be equally divided
between the lawfull Heirs of my
said Daughter —

It is also my further Will and desire
that if my said Daughter should mar-
ry that she should then have immediate
possession of my negro woman Mary
and also that if it should happen
that my personal property be not
sufficient to discharge my debts exclu-
sive of said negro Mary I do request
that Mr. Wm. L. Hunt & Co. of the
part next to Mr. Geo. W. Huntington be sole
in order to purchase the said negro Mary
for my said Daughter and that the Lot
be not sold for any other purpose what-
ever —

I do appoint my loving Wife
executrix and my friend Mr. Edward
Gulland executor of this my last Will
& Testament in order that they may carry
the same into full effect — In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my Hand &
dealt this twentieth day of August 1897
