Black Smiths Tools of all description to him
and his Heirs forever

Item - my wife and desire is that after my
death, my Personal Estate be sold of by my
Executors hereafter named, and be equally
divided between my Children viz Robert -
Wilson, Rich^d Wilson, John Wilson, William
Walker Wymouth Wilson & Rebecca Robinson
Wilson share and share alike

I do hereby constitute my friend & Neighbor
Robert Amstutz & my Brother ^{Rich^d} Wilson
Executors of this my last will and Testament
as witness, my hand & Seal this 9th day
of February 1803
