

And as I have Particulariz'd What I am Owning truly, I will further
Declare that, I have fully Paid Cap^t. Miles King & wish it to be
Record'd that I do not owe him any thing. He once Obtain'd a Note
of me for a trifle, When it was no Justice for me to Pay it, for it was a Debt
of Mr. Finnie's, & then I was no Administrator, & if I was Mary Finnie was
Liable to pay the Halfpenny Debts of Mr. Finnie, However I paid off the note
on Bond, the Whole of it soon after, & Verily Believ'd as he Weigh'd the Money
himself & no body present but myself & him, That he took upwards of Thirty
Pounds in Gold, When the note or Debt was not above £12 or £14, I never
got the Bond Out of his hand, Sometime after I spoke to him & he gave me a
receipt before Mr. Jones of Hampton Dec. and his Daughters, Amelia & Mary
= Jones, I being at their House; The Tax if it is not found among my papers
I have mislaid Cap^t. King knowing that he had Tax all my Money to a trifle
made me some presents about the Value of 4 of Plate, having that he should
say I Ow'd him something, Coll^d. Wethered, by my desire paid him upwards of
£4 for me & took his Tax. The above sum of £12 or £14 was to have been paid by
Cap^t. Tabb of the E. Co^{ty} County, Out of a sum of mine that Mr. Finnie got Cap^t.
Tabb, to him for some years & I believe was paid by him as he was desired to
pay it, but Coll^d. Tabb's papers will show that he Settled with & discharged the
same with Cap^t. King both these Gentlemen being his Uncles there is no
a Doubt but he was paid, My Will is that Whosoever any of my Furniture is
Lodg'd, it belong to the Person with whom it is Lodg'd, I mean Only in the
C. of Elizabeth City, There is a Green Cheston Box of mine in Mr. Brown's
Care, I give the Contents of it Equally betwixt Mr. Brown & Mr. R. Jenkins -
And as it may be thought that at the latter part of my life I had forgot the Poor -
For form it, And as it has appear'd that I am a Lover of the Church of England
& my G. D. and of the poor, I shoud have left something that would have been of Service
to each of them but it is I believe well known that Coll^d. Tabb of N. Carolina has cut
me short of ability to do so, I do hereby Appoint Mr. James, Alias William Branson
of Franklin Co^{ty} N. Carolina, & the Reverend Benjamin Bowser & Henry Jenkins and
of Elizabeth Co^{ty} Virginia, & my Sister Sarah Moody Es^q. ~~of the same~~ Alias Alex^r. Brodie
of N. Carolina Es^q. to this my last Will & Testament to Witness my hand & Seal this Third
third Day of April 1802
