Item My Will and Desire is that Neptune be sold and
the money arising from such sale to be
equally divided between my son Charles Pop and my
Daughters Dianah Pop, Cyprian Pop and Elizabeth Pop

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Charles Pop one
Bed and Furniture and the Bay Horse he usually rides
to him and his Heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath to my son John Pop Malting
Pop one little dressing Table

Item My Will and Desire is that, after all last Debts and
funeral Charges are first paid, all the Residue of my
Estate not before mentioned be equally divided be-
tween my Daughters Dianah Pop Cyprian Pop and
Elizabeth Pop to them and their Heirs for ever And
lastly I nominate and appoint George Barker and
John son Esch Executors to this my last Will & Testa ment
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and
seal this 12th Day of September 1787
