 the use of her wages and namely all debts now due to her for her support and
 comfort but after her death is directed that to be equally divided
 amongst my children

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my loving Son James Goodwin my Negro
 boy Abraham to him and his heirs forever

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my loving Son Martin Goodwin my Negro
 boy Lewis to him and his heirs forever

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my loving Daughter Elizabeth Goodwin
 my Negro Maids Leg and Jack to her and her heirs forever

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my loving Son Robert Goodwin my Negro
 boy Peter to him and his heirs forever

I do hereby Order and appoint my Negro girl male to be sold for the
 best price that can be got and the money arising upon the sale
 to be appropriated to the payment of my debts - and in case there
 shall be more money than I justly owe then the surplus be equally
 divided between my three children above mentioned and my wife
 Elizabeth that all the residue of what I have lawfully received or
 shall receive by my estate I do hereby bequeath unto my wife Elizabeth
 mentioned - and I do hereby bequeath my share in the estate of my
 other Inevitable accident which I make it my request after having
 consulted my Good friend Mr. Martin More of your County and taken his
 advice - but if he shall think it better to be conveyed to my wife
 or her heirs Goods for the relief of my two younger children
 and I do hereby nominate Legatee and appoint my loving wife Elizabeth
 Goodwin my wife and sole Executrix of this my last will and Testament
 in full testimony whereof I do hereby set my hand and affix my seal this
 24th day of November Anno Domini 1749
