 following. I'm p'vise I give my Soul to Almighty God who gave
 it me, And my Body to the Earth, to be decently buried at the discretion
 of my Executors hereafter named, And for what Worldly Estates I am
 Possess'd of, do dispose of the same as follows.

Item I do give & bequeath to my daughter Mable Hunter the bed I now lie in
 together with the Furniture belonging to it, Also one Desk, one large
 oval table, Six leather Chairs and one looking glass.

Item I do give & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Hunter, one Bed and
 the Furniture belonging to it Also one large oval table, Six
 leather Chairs, and one Desk.

Item I give my wearing Apparels to be divided among all my daughters
 And all the residue of my Estate, I desire may be sold to the best
 Advantage, And the Amount thereof, after my Just debts & Fun-
 charges are paid, I give to be equally divided between my three
 Daughters Mary, and Rebecca Hunter, towards their main-
 =ance, and Education. And lastly I do Appoint M^r J^r Brodie
 and M^r W^m Westwood to be Executors this my last will and
 Testament, hereby revoking all other Wills heretofore by me made.
