

In the Name of God Amen I Mary King of the Parish and County of Wiltshire being sick and weak but of perfect Mind and Memory do hereby make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner following

I do hereby give and bequeath my three negroes, Kate, Maud and Susan together with her future Increase and after my said Daughter's Death I give the said Negroes with the Increase to be equally divided between her Children to them and their Heirs, provided that my said Daughter Mary pay that said Debt before she dies, I also intend to my said Daughter Mary the said one Negro girl named Sarah during her life and after her Decease it is my Will and I desire that the said girl Sarah with the Increase be equally divided between my said Daughter's Children and their Heirs

Item, I bequeath to my said Daughter Anne the following Negroes, Peggy, Mary, Henry and Indenture after her Death I give the said Negroes with their Increase to be equally divided between her Children and their Heirs, I also give to my said Daughter Anne during my long looking Glass and one Sea the Bed and Furniture

Item, in consequence of the above Gifts it is my Will and I desire that my said Daughter Anne pay the other half of my said Debt

Item, I give to my son William King one Cow and Yoke of Oxen

Item, I give my Corporation of Old Wiltshire to my son William King

Item, I bequeath to my said Daughter Mary Anne the daughter of my son William King my Negro girl Sarah with her Increase to be during her life and after her Decease the said Negro to be equally divided between her Children and in case no such Children, then and the said Negro Sarah with her Increase to my Grandson John Anne and after his Decease to be equally divided between his Children if in case no Children, then I give the said girl Sarah with her Increase to my son William King and his Heirs

Item, I bequeath to my son William King during his life my plantation on James River but it is my desire that if my said son William King should ever vend the said land to any person he then forfeit all Right to the said land, and after my said son's Death or Forfeiture which should ever first happen then give the said land to my Grandson Thomas King to him and his Heirs

Item, I give all the Rest of my Estate of what kind soever to be equally divided between my loving Daughters Mary and Anne

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Then, it is my Will and desire that in point of my Estate to be sold & Appraised, and it is my further will that Rep^{ts} the Mother of Susan take care of her for two years before my said Daughter part the Child from the Mother, — — — — —
 Lastly I Mandate Mr. Miles King and Mr. Henry to be my Executors to this my last Will and Testament making void all other Wills heretofore made by me In Witness whereof I have hereunto sett my Hand and Affixed my Seal this the Day of October One Thousand seven Hundred & seventy eight

Then, it is my further Will and desire that if said Susan ever my said Daughter Rep^{ts} later should die that the Negro given her with the Increase be equally divided between her Children so far as it can be done and each Child part be third and for the Advantage of each Child In Witness whereof I have hereunto sett my Hand and Affixed my Seal this the Day of October 1778
