 Whereof I have put my Hand and Seal
 the Day and Year above mentioned.

 and assenting to the above Will
 and do agree to confirm the same
 provided it shall not in any
~~left~~ manner affect my Right or Title
 to the money recovered or expected
 to be recovered of a certain Edw.
 Mumford of the Province of
 North Carolina.
