of Sound Mind and Memory do Make and Ordain
this my last Will and Testament in Manner and
Form as follows

First, I give and bequeath, unto my Loving Daughters, —
Rebecca Table, & Mary Table, all my Estate of what
kind so ever to be equally divided between them for
their heirs forever — — — — —
Where, by the last Will and Testament of my Deceased
Husband John Table, he did bequeath to his son John
Table & Henry Table three Negroes each, which I have deliv-
ered unto the said Will, as follows, — to John Table
the following Negro, Jacob a fellow, Patty a Wench &
Peter a Boy, to Henry Table, Daniel a fellow, ~~Rebecca~~
Hannah a Wench and George a Boy — — — — —

Where, my Husband John Table by his last Will and
Testament did require me to move or sell apart two
or three Negroes at my Direction for the Use of my son
Thomas Table provided he did survive me, but as it
pleased the divine Providence to take him before me
I have thought proper to sell apart and give to the heirs
of my said son Thomas, or to those who is Intitled to the
said Negroes by my said Husband's Will, the ^{or three} following

Negress, Grace a Negro Woman of Frank a Negro Man
and Sarah a Negro Woman -
to be divided in the said Will shall direct as my

This my Will and desire that my Executors hereafter named
shall be oblig'd to give my security for the Administration on
my said Estate, nor be held accountable for any

Monstrous and Appoint my Loving Daughter Phebe
as my whole and sole Executor to this my last Will
and Testament. Revoking all other Wills heretofore made
