paid to them and their Heirs for Ever, Item I Give and bequeath all the Rest of my
Estate to be equally divided between my Daughter Mary Sonny and my Son Simon Hollin
Share & Share alike to them & their Heirs for Ever, Item it is my Will & Desire that the Segate
above mentioned shall divide my Estate as above divided without making Sale of
the same I do hereby revoke all former Wills made by me Item my Will & Desire is that
if either of my grand Children Mary Jones or Bourbon Jones should die before they
Marry or come of Lawful Age that then in that Case the Survivor of them should
be entitled to the said fourth Part of my Estate given to them as above but in
Case both of my said grand Children Mary & Bourbon should die before they come
of Age or Marry in that Case my Will & Desire is that 1/2 of my Estate should
be equally divided between my Son Simon Hollin and my Daughter Mary Sonny
to them and their Heirs for Ever. I do hereby appoint my Son in Law M. John Sonny
to be my Executor of this my last Will & Testament I witness whereof I have
