 All my Estate Remaining whatsoever, to him and his Heirs for ever  
 Also John Riddlehurst whom I Likewise constitute, make and Ordain  
 my Sole Ex<sup>or</sup> of this my Last Will and Testament, and I do hereby disannul,  
 revoke and disallow all and every other former Testaments, Wills and Legacies,  
 Bequests and Executors by me in any wise before named, willed and bequeathed,  
 ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my Last Will and Testament.
