to my son Rowen Swain one negro boy named Jupiter.
My Will and desire is that ife this of my Children vizt
Rowen, Kirkpatrick or my daughter Martha Swain shall
at any time hereafter claim any Right, vizt to any part of
Rowen Curles Estate that I have received of it, that the said
claiming shall forfeit one hundred pounds to my Estate,
My Will and Desire is that my loving Wife Jane Swain shall
have two Negroes Wench, Mr. Lucy and Harriack during her
Natural Life, and after her death to Return and be of my
proper Estate I give my said Wife the dwelling House with
the out houses thereto belonging with a third part of the Tract
of Land I live on during her life, I likewise give power
to Mr. Curles to convey the said whereon I now live
Now live & hold and in case it shall not be in the power either
my said Wife nor of my son Rowen Swain I hereby empower
her or him to sell to the best Advantage I likewise empower her
to sell and dispose of any part of my Personal Estate as she
shall think fit to discharge my debts. The remaining part of
my Personal Estate which shall be unpaid I give to my said Wife
during her life, and after to my son Rowen. I likewise
desire that the money that Mr. James Kirkpatrick paid Mr.
William Bowden in London for my son Rowen to Repaid him
