the County and Parish of Edisto City. Do make and
Ordain this to be my last will & Testament in
Manner & form following Ver

I, Nathaniel Yancey unto my Beloved Nathaniel Yancey
son of John Yancey & Eliza his Wife. All my
Estate both Real & personal to him & his heirs
for ever lawfully begotten & his Body & if
he should die without Issue then I give the
said Estate to Joel Yancey son of Joel Yancey
my Brother to him & his heirs for ever. In
case he die without Issue, I then give the said
Estate to the Trustees of the South side of
Back River Greenland and Fox Hill for the use
& Benefit of a school for Education of the poor
Children in that Precinct. as the Trustees
may think proper that no Children of
Baptist parents should be allowed to go to
the said School. and none but those that
are of the Protestant Episcopal Church or
now or may be Established.

Item It is my Will & desire that the Freeholders of
the above Precinct, do Elect or chuse two
Members living in the said Precinct to be
of the Protestant Episcopal Church to have
the sole Management of the said School
and to see good Government thereof. and they
are to rent out the Plantation & to hire out
the Negroes to the best Advantage for the
Benefit of the said School. The Master shall
be Obligated to attend his school —

from one hour by sun in the Morning untill one
 hour by sun at night and that he shall be no
 Dear hand, and a Member of the Church aforesaid
 Him I Give unto Martha Elliott the half a
 Negro fellow named often new, and fifty
 pounds out of the Money due from 'Edincliffe
 Hingham deceased for her Board, which
 is due by Account

Him. My Will and desire is, that my Executors
 hereafter Mentioned may Collect & receive
 all Monies may be due me & pay all my just
 debts & General Expenses

Him. I Appoint ~~John~~ John Lang and Joseph Cooper
 my sole Executors of this my last Will and
 Testament and ~~Relieve~~ ~~to~~ ~~be~~ ~~the~~ ~~Guar-~~
 anties to Nathan Gancey my Nephew
 he come of age and to Manage the Estate as
 they may think proper, for the use of the same
 In Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and seal this 7th day of November 1789

Elizabeth City County Court April 18th 90. While it was proceesed interest, which together
 with the bodily hurts annexed, was granted by the order of the Court to the
 trustee subscribed. And ordered to be recorded ~~and~~ at a Court held at
 Elizabeth City County August 28th 1792. On the Motion of John Young
 for obtaining Letters of Admorsion of the Estate of Nathaniel Young and
 with this Will annexed Whereupon he took the oath with Archibald
 Young and his Laurence entered into and
 after the said death of Nathaniel Young in the County of £1200 conditions
 of the said Will directed.
