Will and Testament in Manner and form as follows

Item, I give to my Daughter Mary Bell one Bed of Turnstone
to her and her Heirs

Item, I give to my Daughter Jane Bell one Bed of Turnstone
to her and her Heirs

Item, I give to my Daughter ^{Mary} Sophia Bell one Pair of Lacy Heirs.

Item, I give to my Daughter Diana Mollony one Jewell Case
giving to her and her Heirs for ever

Item, I send the Plantation where I now live to my loving
Wife during her life, and if my loving Wife dies before
my Daughter ^{Jane Bell} comes to age of Eighteen Years it is my desire the
plantation be rented out for the support of my Daughter Jane
Bell, and after my Wife's Death if my Daughter Jane Bell comes
to age of Eighteen Years it is my Will and I desire that my
plantation be sold by my Executors either one or the more
Arising from the sale to be Equally divided between, John
Bell, James Bell, Mary Bell, Jane Bell and Nathaniel
Ray Bell to them and their Heirs for ever

Item, it is my desire that my loving Wife dispose of such part of
my personal Estate as she shall think proper for the payment
of my Just Debts

Item, I send all the Remainder part of my Estate of what kind
I come to my loving Wife during her life and at her
Death what ever may remain it is my desire it shall be
sold and the Money Arising from such sale to be Equally
divided between my sons, John Bell, James Bell, Nathaniel
Ray Bell, & my Daughters Mary Bell and Jane Bell, to them
and their Heirs for ever

I then it is my desire that my Wife may have the liability for any
accidents that may happen to my stock or furniture
I do hereby appoint my loving Wife Mary Ann Bell my executrix
and Mr Miles King my executor to this my last Will
revoaking all other Wills here before made by my ~~brother~~
whereof there have been to full my Mind & I seal this 12 day of
July 1787
