of the County of Elizabeth City being sick and weak but of sound &
disposing Mind and Memory do make this my last will and
Testament in Manner and Form Following

I praye you I desire that all my Just Debts and Funeral Expenses
be first paid and my Body be decently inter'd at the discretion
of my Executrix hereafter named.

Item I lend the Houses and Lot whereon I now live together
with my Negro Wench Sue, together with my Personal Estate -
during her life for and towards her support, and bringing up
my Children until they shall be fit to be bound out, and after
her Decease all my Remaining Personal Estate together with my
Land and Negro aforesaid with her Increase to be sold and the
Proceeds equally divided amongst my surviving Children. It is my
Will and Desire that my Estate shall all not be appraised or my wife
held to security, And I hereby Appoint my wife Ann Cunningham
whole and sole Executrix of this my last will and Testament
executing and Disannulling all other Wills by me heretofore made.
