Imprimis I Desire that all my Just Debts and Funeral Expences
be first Paid and my Body be Decently Interred at the Discretion
of my Executors hereafter Named

Item I Give the Houses and Lott Whorson I now Live together
with my Negro Wench Sue, together with my Personal Estate
during her Life for and towards her Support, and Bringing up
my Children untill they shall be fit to be Bound out, and after
her Death all my Remaining Personal Estate together with my
Land and Negroes aforesaid with her Increase to be sold and the
to be Equally Divided amongst my Surviving Children. It is my
Will and Desire that my Estate shall not be Appraised or my Wife
held to Security, And I hereby Appoint my Wife Ann Cunningham
Whole and Sole Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament
revoking and Disannulling all Other Wills by me heretofore made
In Testimony whereof I have herunto set my Hand and
Seal this Twente Seventh day of April 1762
