In the Name of God Amen I Robert Armstrong Esq^r of Elizabeth City County
being sick and weak in body but of sound and disposing Mind
do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in Manner &
Form following:

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth
Armistead the following Slaves to wit, Yellow Bob, Jeffery
Lokey, Nelly, Jack, Big Beck and her Child, Phillis,
little Fanny, Sal, and Nelly; the said Negroes to be hired
out annually by my Executrix hereafter named and the Money
arising from the Hire of the said Slaves to be paid to my
loving Mother Elizabeth Armistead during her life forth
espied Expences of supporting herself and my Daughter

Elizabeth Armistead.

Item. My Will and Desire is that all my Lands, Slaves and personal
Estate of every kind, except the Slaves aforesaid, be kept
together during my Mothers Life and during the Widowhood of
my Wife Elizabeth Armistead for their mutual Benefit and
Advantage and after my Mothers Death and the Marriage of
my Wife I give and devise all my Lands in this County and
my Lands lying in York County to my Son William Armistead
to him and to his Heirs forever; but if my Wife
should marry I leave unto her during her natural Life one
Third Part of all my Lands and one Third Party all my.

I give and devise to my Son William Armistead ten Negroe of those that are
remain after my Wifes one. There is taken out for a hire and
for his Benefit of Advantage and then the Remaider of the Negroe
to be equally divided between my wife Lou William and Eliz-
abeth Armistead and it is my further Will and Desire that after
my Mothers Death and the Death of my Wife that all my Negroe
including those given to my Daughter Elizabeth Armistead and
those given to my son William Armistead should be equal-
ly divided between my said Son and Daughter to them during
their Lives for their Use.

Item It is my Will and Desire after the Death of my Mother and
the Marriage of my Wife, that my Stocks of every Kind and
Household and Kitchen Furniture and Plantation
Belongs be sold and the Money arising from the Sale
Brought together with all the Money due me in the County
of North Carolina I give and bequeath the said Money to
my Daughter Elizabeth Armitage. That Money due me
in North Carolina I desire may be collected immediately
at the aforementioned Money I request that it may be placed
in the Treasury of Virginia and the Interest thereof to apply
to the support of my said Daughter Elizabeth until
the coming of Age or Marries and then to draw both the
Principal & Interest.

Item I desire that All the Money due me in this County over
one hundred and twenty dollars be sufficient be applied in the first
Place to the Payment of my just Debts and the Balance
that may be remaining I give unto my Son William Armitage

Item I have only Daughter Elizabeth Armitage should she
die before the coming of Age or Marries then and
in that Case I give unto my Son William Armitage
all the Property that have already devised to her and in
Case my Son William Armitage should die before
he arrives to the Age of twenty one years then I give my
Property that all the Property which I have given
to him should be given to my said Daughter —

Item I desire that all the Property which I have given
to him should be given to my said Daughter —
Elizabeth Armitage and to her heirs for ever
honestly Intend and expect Elizabeth Armitage etc.
Robert Armitage son of W. Armitage, makes his Xth of
November Tenth to be Execution of this my last Will and
