Item I leave all my Goods for the Family use

Item I lend to my loving wife for her lifetime the the third part of my estate

Item I give all the rest of my Estate to be equally divided amongst all my Children
John Cross & Ann Cross & William Cross & Elizabeth Cross & Edward Cross

Item I leave my loving wife Rebecca Cross and my son John Cross Executors
of this my last will and testament hereby Revoking and making void all
others will or willy hearts fore maid by me according to the true intent and
meaning thereof In witness where of I have hereunto set my hand and seal
of Day and year a bove written
