City Do make and Ordain this to be my
last Will and Testament in Manner and
Form following Viz

I have by my two Sisters Martha
Elliot and Ann Burlo ^{the one half of my plan-} ~~all the~~ ^{the one half of my plan-}
tation which I have ^{the one half of my plan-} ~~all the~~ ^{the one half of my plan-}
them or to be of them. I should marry and
them to my will and desire that the ^{one}
half should go to my two Brothers
William and Henry, and their heirs forever
and in case either of the said Brothers should
die without heirs then I may desire that
the surviving Brother should have the
right to his part in the said Land

Robert Elliott's will
of 1733

Item I give unto my Brother Thomas
Elliott the Other half my Plantation to
him and his Heirs for ever. On Condition
his ~~George's~~ Bond due of fifty Pounds
and in Case he should Refuse giving up
the said Bond I then leave the said Land
to be Equally divided Amongst my three
Brothers William Henry & Thomas Elliott
on their paying Thomas the fifty Pounds

Item I lend unto my two Sisters Ann and
Katherine a Boy by name Charles untill
my Brother Thomas comes to Lawfull
Age then I give the said Boy Charles
to my Brother Thomas to him and his
Heirs for ever

Item Its my Will and desire that George
should be sold and the Money from
the sale thereof to be applied towards
paying of my just debts

Item Its my Will and desire that if Black
Horse Shoe shall ^{directly} ~~be~~ ^{be} sold
King should be sure taken him back
and the Money to be applied towards

paying my debts
Item I give unto my Brother Harry my Saddle & Girth
Item I give unto Anne my sister two Cows
to her and her heirs for ever

Item My further Will and Desire that
all the Remainder of my Stock of Cattle

Swine Hogs & Sheep to be sold & the

Money from sale thereof to be applied
towards paying of ^{my} just debts

Item I nominate and Appoint Mr George
Booke my sole Executor of this my last
Will & Testament As Witness my hand
