Item I give and bequeath my Soul to God that gave it and my Body to the Earth from whence it was taken in sure and certain hope through the Merits & sufferings of my blessed Saviour Jesus Christ to receive a joyfull Resurrection at the last day and as to my worldly Goods I give and dispose thereof as followeth

Item I leave to my loving Wife Catherine during her Widowhood all my Estate after my debts & Funeral charges are paid & being of my Children ^{in part} ~~son~~, but if he be insufficient I would have my Executors sell twenty five acres of my Land lying next to the Widow Leuberts Lane and at my Wife's death I would have all or the remainder of the Land sold and the money arising from the sale to be equally divided amongst my sons John, Robt, William Beverly & Josiah Mafsenburg or their Heirs in case either of them should be dead before that time ^{when they} amongst the survivors of them

Item I give and bequeath to my loving Daughter Elizabeth Mafsenburg sixteen pounds of the Money which I have in the Loan office to be recd when she Marries or arrives to the age of Eighteen years

Item My desire is that at my Wife's death all the remainder of my Estate be sold and the Money arising therefrom be equally divided amongst all my surviving Children or in case any of them should be dead leaving Children lawfully begotten then Children or child should have the part that would have belonged to these parents

Item My Will and desire is that if my Wife should Marry after my decease that she should have the third of my Estate except the Legacy ^{above} as the Law directs for Widows

Item My Will is that I would not have my Estate Appraised nor an Inventory returned to Court

Item I hereby ordain constitute & appoint My loving Wife Catherine Mafsenburg and my ~~son~~ ^{Heirs} Joseph Mafsenburg of Warwick to be my Lawfull Executors of this my last Will
