 her Decease I give the use and Labour of the said
 negro boy I give my to Robert Tucker Casey ^{my son} During
 his natural life, and in case Robert
 Tucker Casey should die ~~leaving~~ ^{leaving} no Issue of his
 body in that case I give the said negro to my Cousin
 Thomas Hibble & his Heirs for ever.

I Give the use and labour of my two negro fellows
 Saml & Lewis to ^{my son} Robert Tucker Casey During
 his natural life ~~and after his decease~~ and in
 case Robert Tucker Casey should happen to die
 without Issue of his body in that case I give the
 said two negroes to my Cousin Thomas Hibble
 and his Heirs for ever

I Give the use and labour of my negro wench
 Jane to my Cousin Thomas Hibble & his Heirs
 Robert Tucker Casey arrives to the Age of twenty one
 years and in case Robert Tucker Casey should
 come to lawfull age in that case I give the said
 negro wench Jane to ^{my son} Robert Tucker Casey &
 his Heirs for ever

My will & Desire is that my two negro fellows
 Saml & Lewis shall be hired out by my Executors
 here after mentioned and the Money Arising by
 such hire to be apply'd towards the Discharge of my
 Just Debts

Item My Will & Desire is that my two Negroes
Sam & Lewis shall be kept by my Executor
till my Son Robert Tucker Casey shall
arrive to the age of twenty one years

All the residue of my Estate of what kind so
ever I desire may be sold to a use the Discharge
of my Just Debts

Lastly I Give, devise and appoint my Son
Robert Casey my whole & sole Executor of this
my Last will and he to see all the same
and make up paid all for once with by law
before made I will that whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal
