put out to Interest til he arrives to the Age of twenty one year
and I do hereby appoint my Wife Sammett Wheeler to be my
whole & Sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament
Rescinding and Disannulling all other Wills heretofore by me
made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and this 30th Day of December 1747
