I give to my mother one cow and calf & four sheep I give
 them to her for ever

I give to my mother one tree of one in pot. I give
 to her for ever

and after this I do leave and bequeath unto my daughter
 to be my sole executrix of my last will & testament I give
 and I following all things with my made allowing her
 to have the full power of the same I do
 and I at this day of Jan. 1748
