be to almighty God for the same doe make and ordain this to be
my last will & testament in manner and form following viz.

I give and bequeath unto my Loving son Tho^s Rogers
Rogers one negro man named Will to him and his
heirs forever & this money he is hired for in the year 1768

I give & bequeath unto my above son Tho^s Rogers one
feather bed and furniture, One large Chest one puter
dish and plate & one old Cubard One Dead Cow &
Calf

I give unto my above son Tho^s Rogers two iron pots
one frying pan & potshack & one sp. spoon moulded

I give and bequeath unto my three grand Children
Elizabeth Smith Mary Smith & Anne Smith the Rem-
ainder or part of my Cattle to be Equally divided
amongst my three above Grand Children

I give unto my Loving granddaughter Elizth Smith
one box iron

I give & bequeath unto my above Grand Children Elizth
Mary & Anne Smith the Remainder or part of my puter
to be Equally divided amongst them likewise my
wearing Cloaths

and my will and desire is that the same be not divided
nor appraised and I doe appoint my son Tho^s Rogers
Tucker Smith to be whole & sole Executor of this my
last will & Testament in witness whereof I have set
my hand and seal this 25 day of Decem^r 1753
