I give & bequeath to my Son Tho: Bayliff & to his
heirs for Ever, the Plantation, whereon I now
with all the privileges & Appurtenances thereunto
belongin - I give to my Son Thos one large Table
one chest & one large set of Stilards & one Iron
Spit, & one set of Iron traces but of traces not to be had till after my
Wifes decease ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

I give & bequeath to my Son William Bayliff &
to his heirs for Ever, that Plantation or parcel
of land commonly call'd and known by the name of
Black wolnot Ridg. being by Estimation, about the
size acres be it some more or less, with all privi-
leges & Appurtenances thereunto belonging -
I give to my Son William one feather bed & the furni-
ture belonging to it, I give to my Son William one
feather bed & to with the furniture belonging to it
after my Wifes decease, I give to my Son William
one handmill one leather Cutch, one large Chest
and one Iron Spit & one set of small Stilards & one
gun one large Iron pot & to Iron wedge, & one
mol with Iron rings, & one Horse one man
after my wife's decease & all my Iron pot racks -

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Edith Bayliff
and to her heirs for Ever one feather Bed with
furniture belonging to it & one small Iron pot
& one hundred pounds of tobacco & six barrels of corn
I give to my Daughter Mary Abrahams one gown
some with furniture belonging to it ~ ~ ~

I give to my son William & daughter Edith Baylis
all my goods to be equally divided between them after
my wife's decease -

I give to my son John Baylis one pound ten shillings
and lastly I appoint my son Tho: & William Baylis
Executors, with my Loving wife Mary Baylis Execut-
rix to be this my last will and Testament truly
performed in witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand & Seal this fourteenth day of Sept-
one thousand seven hundred & forty one

Memorandum.

That James Bailey declared in presence of us the subject
His last Will and Testament to be as follows.

Wit: That His Mother ~~the~~ Judith Bailey should take his Estate into her
Possession, and apply it, or such part thereof as shall be necessary, for
The Maintenance of the Child that then cometh now goes with; to
such time as the said Child shall be bound out; And that then the surplus
of the said Estate to be the property of the said Child; But in case the
said Child die before such binding out, then the said James Bailey
should give the said Estate, or surplusage thereof to his Brother
Joseph Bailey; In Testimony Whereof we have hereunto set our
hands and seals this 14th day of March 1741/2
