I mean in Case my said Daughter Judith Burke King Dies
before she comes of Age or Marries, that the Negroes, Nancy
Jack & Violet & Their Future Increase be Equally Divided
among all my Other Children —

I Also Give & Bequeath to my said Daughter Judith C. King
Six Silver Tea Spoons & a Bed & Turnstone also some Pewter
Plates & Three Dishes also China & Iron China Plates & a large
Linen China Dish also a Little Spinning Wheel, The Big Spinning
Wheel I give my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Burges,
Item, I Give my Son Joshua C. King a Bed & Curtains & a
young Man,
Item, I Give & Bequeath to my Son Henry Jenkins King a Bed
& a young Horse,

I Give my Son John C. King my Loom & all its Appurtenances
Item I Give my Son William King all my Crocheting & Laces Tools
&c.

I Also Give my Son William my whole Stock of Bees, & my Hogs to my
Son John C. King, Witness my Hand & Seal this 22nd of March 1796
