 whereon I now live during the term of her natural  
 life and after her decease I give the said Plantation  
 to William Clark and his heirs for ever  
 I do give and bequeath to my nephew William  
 Clark Twelve acres of land purchased of John William  
 to him and his heirs for ever  
 I give and bequeath to my nephew William Lewis one  
 cow one sow and one large Pance to him and his heirs  
 for ever  
 I desire that all the Remainder of my Estate be imme-  
 diately sold after my Decease, and out of the money  
 arising therefrom all my just debts and funeral  
 Expenses be paid, and if there should be any money  
 Remaining after the Payments of my just debts,  
 I give it to my sister Ann Clark to her and her  
 heirs for ever, and lastly I do hereby Constitute and  
 appoint my sister Ann Clark Executor of this my  
 last will and Testament In witness whereof I have  
 hereunto set my Hand and affixed my seal this 30th  
 day of December 1804
