ordain this to be my last Will and Testament I do hereby revoke  
all other Wills, following manner and form. Item I bind my  
Plantation to my beloved Wife that I bought of Mr. James Barker  
during her life after her Death my Will is that the said  
Land shall return to my Daughter Frankey Skinner.  
Item my Will is that my beloved Wife shall cut as much  
timber after the Plantation as Fox Hill as she thinks pro-  
per for the use of that said Land that shall my be-  
loved Wife Item my Will is my Daughter Frankey  
Skinner shall cut as much timber of the Plantation at  
Fox Hill as she thinks proper for the use of the said  
Land that I give her after her my Wife Death.  
Item my Will is that my beloved Wife shall have the  
use of my Negro Woman Else till my Daughter Frankey Skinner  
comes to the age of one and twenty years then I give the said  
Negro Woman Else to my Daughter Frankey Skinner, my Will  
is if my Wife thinks proper to sell the said Negro Woman Else and  
my Wife to buy a Negro Girl about fourteen years of age for  
my Daughter Frankey Skinner. Item my Will is my Wife shall  
have the use of the said Negro Girl till my Daughter Frankey  
Skinner comes to the age of one and twenty years then I give  
the said Negro Girl to my Daughter Frankey Skinner.  
Item I give my beloved Wife too the first choice of my Beds  
but if my Wife should marry then I give too first choice of  
my Beds to be equally divided between my son Thomas Skinner  
and my Daughter Frankey Skinner. Then I give to my Wife  
the four of first choice of my Cattle but if my Wife should

then I give the four Head of cattle to be equally divided between my son Thomas Skinner and my daughter Franky Skinner Then I give to my wife all my stuff but if my wife should marry then I give all my stuff to be equally divided between my son Thomas Skinner and my Daughter Franky Skinner Then I give my plantation as How Hill to be equally be divided between my son John Skinner and my son Thomas Skinner and my Daughter Mary Skinner My Will is that two men of judges shall equally divide my plantation at Fox Hill between my son John Skinner and my son Thomas Skinner and my Daughter Mary Skinner My Will is that my son John Skinner and son Thomas Skinner and Daughter Mary Skinner shall have lots for the first Choice of the Land then I gave them And my Will is after Powell and Death then I give my daughter Margaret Seward six acres of land out of the Land that I give to my Daughter Mary Skinner My Will is after Margaret Seward Death then I give the six acres of Land to my Daughter Mary Skinner Then I give to my son Skinner my Negro Man Black and my Will is that my son John Skinner shall give my wife ten Branches of corn as long my wife does not die Then I give all my Branches to be equally divided between my Daughter Margaret Seward and my Daughter Mary Skinner and my wife and my son John Skinner to be equally be divided between them Then I give all my cattle between my son John Skinner and my Daughter Mary Skinner and my son Thomas Skinner and my Daughter Franky Skinner to be equally be divided between my son John Skinner

and my son Thomas Skinner and my daughter Mary Skinner and my Daughter Dorothy Hoxsey Skinner.  
I do give all my House and Goods to be equally divided between my son John Skinner and my son Thomas Skinner and my Daughter Mary Skinner and my Daughter Dorothy Hoxsey Skinner. Lastly I appoint my loving Wife and John Skinner Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoke all other Wills before made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty third Day of May One thousand seven hundred and forty six.

At a Court held for Eliz City County October the 25<sup>th</sup>

1776

This Will was presented in Court and proved by the Deathers of Henry Howard Birmingham and John Powell two of the Testifiers thereto and ordered to be Recorded and at another Court held for the said County the 27<sup>th</sup> Day of February 1777 On the Motion of John Skinner the Executor named in the said Will who made oath according to Law certificati<sup>n</sup> is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form upon his giving Security thereupon together with Thomas Wootten and Thomas Wootten his Securitie intercainted and acknowledged Board the Liberty resorce for the Execution of his will in the place where he resided.
