two hundred & sixty Acres to him and his Heirs for ever
Item I give unto my Son Robert Armistead my
young black Mare Item I give unto my Son Robert
Armistead Six young Cows & two Yoke of Steers to be at
his own Choice. Item I give to my Son Westwood Armistead
a piece of land four hundred and sixty & eight Acres of
Sand lying on Sawyers Swamp & known by the
Name of rigg Sand to him and his Heirs for ever
Item it is my desire that ^{the} following Negroes be equally
divided between my Sons Robert Armistead & Westwood
Armistead. to W. I. Pompey. Nat. George. Peter. Abram
Jeffrey. Charles. Nancy. Rachel. Dolly. Lucy. Lucy
Lydia. & the three increase.

I leave the remaining part of my Estate not given
by this Will it is my desire that the same be sold to
the best Advantage & after my Just debts are paid
of the remaining money arising from the Said Sale
be equally divided between my Sons Robert Armistead
& Westwood Armistead. Item if my Sons Robert Armistead
& Westwood Armistead should either of them die before they
come of age or marry it is my Will and desire that the
Survivor ~~to~~ take the Estate of the deceased & I give the same
to the Survivor this heirs for ever. Item I do hereby appoint
my Wife Mary Armistead Executrix & my Son
Robert Armistead Executor of this my last Will &
Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and Seal this 18th day of January one
thousand ^{Seven} Hundred Eighty two.
