is that my Loving wife have the use of all my Estate till my
said Children Cum to Age or Day of Marriag for the Maintenance
and Schooling of them and that when she or either of them
Cum to Age or married that then they have there equal parts
paid them, and I do Nominate and appoint my loving
wife Jane Allen my ~~executrix of this my~~ will & Testament Revoking and Disallowing any other will
before made by me to be woyd, and that this to be my only
Last will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my Hand & Seal this 11th day of June 1752.
