heirs for ever I constitute and appoint my loving
wife Prothier Alin my whole and sole Executrix of this my
last will testament working all other wills and testaments
whatsoever as witness my hand and seal this 21st day
of June 1749 I have signed unto my daughter Judith Alin my
Will and she has signed her name before the signing
and sealing of these presents
