County of Erie City being sick and weak of body and mind my mind be
God for his sake do make and ordain to go my last will and Testament in manner
form as follows first and principally I do command my soul to Almighty God kept good it
keeping through the fruits of my blessed salvation Jesus Christ to receive full pardon and forgiveness
of all my sinnes and my body to the Earth to be buried at the discretion of my said wife where after
I bind and set my worldly goods & possessions as follows with
first I will that all my just debts be paid and discharged

I will and appoint that my two Negro servants John and Rose be my Servants & held toward my death
I will also my personal Estate to be equally distributed among my children
John & James and Elizabeth who my Daughter Anna Maria Annis and my two Negro's Coffey and George
to her and his son for service

Item I bind the wife and Master of my two Negroes John & Rose unto my loving wife Charlotte and back
During her Natural life only in Diff'rent cases she & I give them two Negro's and two Negro's and two Negro's wife
to be equally divided between my two daughters and Anthony Brewster and Mary Young (his wife)
last will dissolved off but is not at this time baptiz'd so it is to remain and hold him for his son

Now I give you and Squarts wife my loving son William Brewster and my Negro boy Andrew to him
and his wife forever
Also I give you and Squarts wife my loving son Anthony Brewster and my Negro girl Lydia to him and
his wife forever

Also I give you and Squarts wife my loving son John Brewster and my Negro boy Harry to
him and his wife forever

You stand me up and I call on you to make a man of me —
I now and forever discharge my duty & I after the expectations of the said Lord God of heaven and Squarts wife
My Negro Mammie Brewster and my son John Brewster I give you both my love and my blessing for ever &
And lastly I hereby name, walk and appoint my loving wife Elizabeth Brewster and my loving
Brother Dennis Brewster and Elizabeth Brewster and Dennis Brewster and my wife Elizabeth Brewster
reserveling all forces and means to defend and support her before all men before she is widowed or when of age
I now call it my will and I do and I sign and affix my hand heretofore the 7 day of July 1741

Memory do make this my last Will and Testament in manuscript
Form following

I implores I recommend my soul to God the Creator and give of it and my
Body to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executrix
hereafter named

And unto my Temporal Estate after my debts and
funerals are paid and discharged

I give I lend to my loving Wife Constance all my Estate of what Tittle or
Claim soever during her life for the support of herself and Childred
and my Will is that my Wife maintain my Son Robert's Negro Nan
till she can be husband and that my Wife may have power to charge
my Son Robert for his maintenance to the amount of the hire of
said Negro Nan

I give I bequeath after my Wife's death my whole Estate to be equally
divided between my three Children allowing the Negro Nan to
be appraised and for each Child to have equal share alike of Estate
but if my Son Robert will not agree to have his Negro appraised
with my Estate my desire is that my Estate as aforesaid be
equally divided between my daughter Mary and my Son Robert
Armed to them and their Heirs forever

I nominate and appoint my loving Wife Constance my sole
Executrix of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all
former or other Wills by me heretofore made and declaring this
this to be my only true last Will and Testament In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this twenty-fourth
Day of February 1772
