Estate during her Naturall life, & after her
Decease, I then give it to be Equally Divided
between the Children of my Brother George Bookers

Marshall, & my Son W^m Marshall to be
my Exe^{tr} & Exec^{tr} of this my last will and
Testament. in witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & scale this 14th Day of October
1734
