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In the name of god amen I William Sandefur
of the County of Elizabeth City being in perfect
health and of Sound mind Memory and understanding
but considering the uncertainty of this transitory life
do make publish and declare this my last Will and
Testament in Manner and form following

I leave unto my wife Elizabeth one bed and furniture one
mare saddled and bridle two Cows and calves one Sow and
ten Sheds two yokes and lambs one Chest two dishes
and six plates one pot and pan two fat pots one spin
ning wheel and Cards one pair of flaterins and Six
Chairs and ten pounds in hand money and all the

rest of my Estate to be divided between my Child

Robert Sandefur Mollea Sandefur Richard
Sandefur and Pathea Sandefur and at my
wife death or day of Marriage the hole that I leave
to her to be divided between Mollea Sandefur
