 to all the rest residue and Remainder of my Estate and Effects both real
 and personal of what nature or kind soever I leave devise
 and bequeath the same to my Brother Andrew Thompson his Heirs Executors
 Administrators and assigns for ever and appoint him my Sole residuary
 Legatee and Executor In witness whereof I have hereunto put my
 Hand and Seal and published and declared this to be my last Will and
 Testament this Tenth day of April 1703.
