Perfect sence and memory thanks be given to Almighty god
do Appoint this to be my last will and Testament in
manner as Followeth &c —

Imp^r. I Lend to my Loving Wife Rebaca Weymouth during
her life or widow hood the use of the Plantation whereon
I now live, and in Case she should Marry ^{any further}
will and devise is that she shall not be proceeded with
any of my Land —

Item. I give to my Eldest son John Weymouth after my wife's
Decease or marriage fifty Acres of Land part of my said
Plantation, beginning at a Pine Tree on the West side by
the Swamp and running thence Easterly to Chestnut oak
Joining the school Land all the Land the north side of
the said Line including the bounds round to him and
his Heirs for Ever.

Item. I give to my son James Weymouth after my Wife's
Decease or marriage the other fifty Acres of my said
Plantation. (viz) all the Land on the south side of
the Dividing line including the bounds round
to him and his Heirs for Ever —

Item. I lend to my Loving Wife Rebaca Weymouth the use
of a Negro Wench named Frank during her life or
Widow hood. & after her Death or marriage I give the
said wench Frank with her increase to my son
William Weymouth and his heirs for Ever.

Item. I Lend to my Loving Wife Rebaca Weymouth
all my Personal Estate ^{in Cash} during her life or widow
hood to support my Children and give them Education
and what ever remains after my ^{Wife's} decease or marriage
to be Equally divided amongst my ^{in my daughters} by my Executors
When they shall Come of Age or marry —
