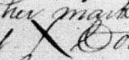

the uncertainty of this transitory life and that all flesh must yield unto death
when it shall please God to Call do make Confessate ordains & declare this my
Last Will & Testament In manner and form following Revoking & annulling
by these presents all & every Testament & Testaments Will or Wills heretofore by me
made and declared in writing or by word or writing and this only to be taken for my last

My last Testament & none other Just I give and bequeath my soule unto Almighty
 God my Saviour & Redeemer hoping to receive his pardon & Remission of all my sins,
 and to inherit the Kingdom of Heaven, and my body to be buried in such decent
 place & manner as it shall please my Exec^r. Hereafter named to appoynt, And
 now for the settling of my temporall Estate, as it hath pleased God to bestow upon me,
 I do dispose of the same in manner & forme following that is to say, I give & bequeath
 unto my eldest sonne Leonard that plantation he now lives upon,
 adjoyning to it Land off John Brooks being formerly of Land of John Matthews,
 with all the Appurtenances thereunto belonging to him & his heirs for ever, Here
 I doe give unto my son Thomas my son William & my son John this plantation I
 now live upon to be equally divided, amongst them only my son Thomas out of
 his amound of y^e plantation to have all the housing, fencing, Gardens, Orchards, with
 his husband's Cows, being one third off of Land, And I do order & appoynt that my son
 William to have his dividend off Land adjoyning upon y^e Quole Spring Swamp begu-
 ing where his Brother Thomas Ends, Furthermore I do order & appoynt that my son
 John have his Dividend of Land upon y^e Ware Channel adjoyning upon his Brother
 Leonard beginning where his Brother Thomas Ends, to them & their heirs for ever.
 Lastly I do order & appoynt that all these debts & duties as I owe in Right or Con-
 science to any manner of person or persons what soever shall be well &
 lawfully Contented & paid or ordered to be paid within convenient time after my
 decease Appoynting my son Thomas sole Executo^r. Of this my last Will & Testament
