following. I Give & bequeath my Soule to Almighty God that gave it me with a
sure and certain hope of a joyfull Resurrection through the merits of my blessed
Lord & Saviour Iesus Christ & my body into my weathor the Earth & for my
worldly estate in manner & form following. after my just & Lawfull Debts are
paid & satisfied I give unto my eldest son John Boughton this plantation where I
now live on. beginning at the Walnut tree as up the Hay gate beante to the
mouth of my spring beante thence along the Lyege Road to the fore of a small
beante by a cross thence up the South West that makes up to Christopher Smiths
field thence to a stepping stone standing in Frenmans hie by the hedge to him
& his heirs for ever. I Give my son James Boughton all my Land on the south
East side of the Hay gate beante known by the name of the plantation to him
& his heirs for ever. I give unto my son Abner Boughton the remainin part of
y^e Land I bought William Ards & the remainin part of that Land I now live on
that is not already appointed to him & his heirs for ever. I give unto my two
youngest sons Thomas Boughton & Ben Boughton a certain parcel of Land lying in
Essex & Luce County known by the name of the Mount maine 2000 to be equally
divided between them to them & their heirs for ever. But if either of them should die
without issue the share to have the whole of Land my beloved wife Sarah Boughton y^e
wife of all my Lands during her life. I Give my wife the use of my Mills for 1000
years & for the bargain up & give my Children Charles my two sons John & James
& Abner & Charles & Ben to taught to read & write & amount as for a the
rule of Division & after the 1000 years is expired I give my Mills to my son
James Boughton to him & his heirs for ever. I also appoint my Loving wife Sarah
