if any heretofore made by me - First I bequeath my Soul into the hands of my
mercifull God who gave it, hoping all my Sins shall be forgiven me in & through
the worth of my Saviour Jesus Christ in full & certain hopes of the redemption
at the last day, Then I bequeath my Body to the Earth whence it was taken
to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned. Item
I give and bequeath unto Elizabeth Charles, Frances Charles and Ann Ho-
cath of them a good ring of twenty shillings, being in full as their portion.
Item I give and bequeath unto Ann Charles the daughter of Frances
Charles thirty pounds Sterl. Lastly I do give and bequeath unto my son
William Dangerfield all the rest of my Estate both real & personal which
I constitute and appoint whole and sole Executor of this my Last will and
Testament. Furthermore, his my will & desire if my Estate be not brought to an
appraisement In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this thirteenth
day of October one thousand seven hundred and thirteen
