at the discretion of My Executor herein after named & as for my worldly estate
I am pleased God to be bestowed upon my wife & my children as follows

Item I give & bequeath unto my God daughter Elizabeth Talbott one & a half of the
value of ten shillings to be paid to her after my decease

Item I give & bequeath unto my loving wife Mary Talbott all the residue of my estate to her
sole & personal use in it & the profits & the interest to use & receive & dispose of as she shall see cause

and lastly I do bequeath unto my said wife Mary Talbott all the residue of my estate to her
sole & personal use in it & the profits & the interest to use & receive & dispose of as she shall see cause

Talbott my whole & sole Executor in my last will & testament & to have & receive & dispose of as she shall see cause
I have written & signed these words & the above said last will & testament & have signed my name
