 after her decess I give and dispense thereof as followeth (that is to say) I  
 give unto my said Daughter Mary the negro woman named Frans & with  
 her increase to her & her heire for ever Item I give unto my  
 Daughter Mary the son of god & inheritance Table Item I give unto  
 my said Daughter Rebetta the black man named Fank to her & her  
 heire for ever and also I give unto my said Daughter Rebetta one  
 bed and furniture & one Table Item I give unto each of my  
 yong children one Cow or Cows together with their increase Item I give  
 unto Will Robson one young miffer and one 2:2:2 bedding now with their  
 increase Item are the residue & remainder of my estate I give unto  
 my said children the w<sup>th</sup> Mary & Rebetta to be equally divided betwix  
 them share and share alike all just debts & smotull executes being first  
 satisfied and paid Lastly I nominate & appoint my said dear wife Rebetta  
 to hole & hold the tutrie of this my last will & to stand by me in any & every  
 former & other wills by me at any time heretofore made be herely health &便利 let to my self &
