In the name of God amen the fourth day of
April seventeen hundred and twenty two I William Eit of South Carolina residing
in the County of York being first in body out of good & perfect memory having
to Almighty God & calling to remembrance the uncertain State of this Transitory
Life & that all things must yield unto Death when it shall please God to call
me home to that Ordain & declare this my Last Will & Testament in manner &
form following receding & annulling by these presents all & every former Will by
me heretofore made or declared by word or writing & that is to be taken only for
my Last Will & Testament. I now utter and first being content & very free the
bottom of my heart for my sins past meet humbly desiring forgiveness for I fear
I have & commit my Soul unto Almighty God my Saviour & Redeemer in whom
& by the Merits of Jesus Christ I trust & believe assuredly to be saved & to
have full remission & forgiveness of all my sins & that my Soul to my Joy
at the general day of Resurrection shall rise again to live & through the merits of

First death and passion popes & further the Kingdom of Heaven prepared for
 his self & soul & my body to be buried in such sort & Christian manner
 as it shall please my Ex^{or} hereafter named to appoint and now for the settling of
 my Temporall Estates & with good friends & debts as it hath pleased God far
 above my desire to bestow upon me I do order give & assign the same in man-
 & form following that is to say First I will that all high debts & Dutys as I
 am in Right or Confidure to any manner of person or persons whatsoever shall
 be well & truly contented & paid or ordained to be paid wth in convenient time after
 my decease by my Ex^{or} hereafter named. Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved
 Children John Eliz^{eth} Mary & Ann all my goods & Chattels equally to be
 divided amongst them but that my daughter Ann be maintained out of my Estate
 for one whole year. Item my will & desire is that Eliz^{eth} the wife of
 Joseph Brown take my daughter Ann after one year is expired & so to
 continue she arrives to the age of Eighteen years or day of Marriage w^{ch}
 shall first happen. Item my will & desire is that my Ex^{or} for Executors
 by the name of John M^{rs} Comtague do take & keep the rest of my Children
 and at his discretion maintain them till they come to the age of Eighteen
 years or day of Marriage which shall first happen and that he Joseph &
 keep the plantation whereon I now live till my Ex^{or} John comes of age
 & I do hereby constitute the Ex^{or} John M^{rs} Comtague my whole & sole Ex^{or}
 by my Last Will & Testament. As witness my hand & seal of day & year w^{ch} is
 written.
