3) In the name of God amen, the fourteene day of
April seventeen hundred and twenty two in the year of our Lord Jesus Christ
in the County of York being first made out of good & present memory between me &
the Almighty God & calling to remembrance the uncertain estate of this Temporal
life & that all flesh must yield unto death when it stands given to fall to
make Constitute & ordaine this my last Will & Testament in manner &
form following receding & containing by these presents all & every Estate & thing
me heretofore made or declared by word or writing & that is to be had in my said
my last Will & Testament & none other and first being written & carryed from the
bottom of my heart for my Sons next meijt trouing deficiency forgiueness for y^r said
& thine & Commit my Soul unto Almights hand my Vicere & Intercessor in this
& by the Mercies of Jesus Christ & trust & reliance affirmdly to be given to
have full remission & forgiueness of all my Sins & that my Soul to my Master
at the general day of Resurrection shall arise again to joy & thenceforth nevermore

In my death and funeral yokes I fulfill the commandment of Heaven prepared for
 me that I should & my body to be buried in such decent & Christian manner
 as it shall please my good warkt named to appoint and now for the settling of
 my temporall Estates & with Good brother & debts as it shall please God far
 above my deathe to brieve upon me I do ordene this & direct the same in manner
 & form following that is to say First I will that all those debts & Dutys as I
 am in Right or Consideration to any maner of person or persons w^t good I shall
 be well & truly contented & paid or ordained to be paid within convenient time after
 my decease by my executors named. Item I give & bequeath unto my children
 William John & Mary & Ann all my goods & chattell equally to be
 divided amongst them but that my daughter Ann be maintained out of my Estate
 for one whole year. If then my will & desire is that Mrs. the wife of
 Joseph Brown take my daughter Ann after one year is expired & care for her
 until she arrives to the age of eighteen years or day of marriage w^t
 shall first happen. Item my will & desire is that my son Mr. Brown
 by the name of John H. Comptague do take & have the rest of my Chattell
 and at his discretion maintain them till they come to the age of eighteen
 years or day of marriage which shall first happen and that he & his
 son this plantation wherein I now live till my son be come of age
 & I do hereby constitute this of John H. Comptague my whole & sole Execut^r of
 this my last Will & Testament. As witness my hand & seal of day & year written
