 (thanks be to almighty God) do make and ordain this my last will & Testament in
 manner & form following (that is to say) I give & bequeath my Soul into the hands
 of my mercifull Creator in hopes of Salvation through the merits & Intercession of
 my blessed Redeemer, my body I bequeath to the Earth to be decently buried in
 Christian burryall at the discretion of my Exors & Admins after mentioned, as to
 what worldly goods it hath pleased almighty God of his infinite mercy to bestow on
 me I give and dispose thereof as followeth (that is to say) I give unto my
 Daughter Elizabeth wife of Thomas the plantation whereon they now live
 to her and her heirs for ever. I give & give unto my Daughter Mary the wife
 of William Hottel the plantation whereon they now live to her & her heirs
 for ever. I give unto my Daughter Rebecca the plantation whereon I
 now live after the decease of me and [redacted] wife) to her and her heirs for ever
 I give unto my Dear wife Rebecca Pritchard all the rest of my State
 Real and personall to use and enjoy the same during her naturall life and
 after her decease I give and dispose thereof as followeth (that is to say) I
 give unto my said Daughter Mary the negro woman named Francis with
 all her increase to her & her heirs for ever. I give unto my
 Daughter Mary one silver bed & furniture & one Table. I give unto
 my said Daughter Rebecca one silver man named Jack to her & her
 heirs for ever and also I give unto my said Daughter Rebecca one
 silver bed and furniture & one Table. I give unto each of my
 ye and children one Cow or two yoke with their increase. I give
 unto Mr. Robinson one young mares and one x: x: x: weeding sow with their
 increase. I give all the residue & Remainders of my State I give unto
 my said children Mr. Mary & Rebecca to be equally divided between
 them share and share alike, all just debts & summs being first
 satisfied and paid. Lastly I nominate & appoint my said Dear wife Rebecca
 whole & sole executrix of this my last will & Testament hereby giving power
 unto her with by me at any time hereafter made & lawfully published & signed
 & sealed in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 5th day of July 1720
