 my blessed Redeemer my body I bequeath to the Earth to be decently buried in
 Christian buryall at the discretion of my Executor herein after mentioned as to
 what worldly goods it hath pleased almighty god of his infinite mercy to bestow on
 me I give and dispose thereof as followeth that is to say Item I give unto my
 Daughter Elizabeth wife of Thomas the planteation wheroun shee now live
 to her and her heire for ever Item I give unto my Daughter Mary the wife
 of William Fletcher the plantation wheroun they now live to her & her heire
 for ever Item I give unto my Daughter Rebetta the plantation wheroun
 shee now live after the decess of me and my wife to her and her heire for ever
 Item I leave unto my Deare wife Rebetta Pritchard all the rest of my estate
 Real and personall to use and enjoy the same during her naturall life and
 after her decess I give and dispense thereof as followeth (that is to say) I
 give unto my said Daughter Mary the negro woman named Frans & with
 her increase to her & her heire for ever Item I give unto my
 Daughter Mary the sonnes god & inheritance Table Item I give unto
 my said Daughter Rebetta the black man named Fank to her & her
 heire for ever and also I give unto my said Daughter Rebetta one
 halfe god & furniture & one Table Item I give unto each of my
 yong children one Cow or Cows yeller with their increase Item I give
 unto Will Robson one young miffer and one 2:2:2 bedding now with their
 increase Item are the residue & remainder of my estate I give unto
 my said children the w: Mary & Rebetta to be equally divided betwix
 them share and share alike all just debts & smotull executes being first
 satisfied and paid Lastly I nominate & appoint my said dear wife Rebetta
 to hole & hold the tutrie of this my last will & to stand by me in any chancery cause
 former or other wills by me at any time hereafter made be heire to my Estates to be my Executrix
 I haue set in witness before I have signed & sealed this 11th day of July 1710
 And I have caused this to be published in the parsonage of us
