Tyres of the parish of St. Andrews in the County of York being
very sick and weak in body but of perfect mind and memory -
knowing to be given to God therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my
body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do
make and ordain this my Last will and Testament. That is to say
primarily and first of all I give and bequeath my soul into y^e hands
of God that gave it and for my body I bequeath it to his earth to be

Buried in a Christian Libe and Devout manner at the Discretion of my Exors
 working Doubting but at the Generall Resurrection I shall revive the same again by the
 mighty power of God and by working such worthy Acts wherewith it shall please
 God to best me with in this life I give Devise and Dispose of the same in the
 following manner and form I give and bequeath unto my well
 beloved wife Ann whom I likewise Constitute make and ordain my whole and
 sole Exor of this my last will and Testament thirty pounds Current money to be
 payed out of my Estate and her own feather bed and furniture Item I give to my son
 Thomas my negro man named Robt but in Case either of my wife's two negroes
 that was withed to her by her former husband Thomas Moadsbe should die my
 will is that my wife keep the same as good Negroes Robt during of her Natural
 life Item I give and bequeath my negro woman named Jude to my Daughter Sarah
 keeping the following Issue Vizth the first born Slave Child I give to my son Samuels
 to be Delivered when it is a year old to him and his heirs for ever: the second born
 Slave Child I give to my Child unborn to be Delivered when it is a year old to him or
 her heirs for ever: the third I give to my Daughter Ann to be Delivered to her when
 it is a year old: and the fourth born Slave Child I give to my Daughter Deborah to be
 Delivered to her at a year old to her and heirs for ever: And the remainder of her
 Issue I give to my Daughter Sarah and to her heirs for ever Item I give my negro
 boy James to my son Samuels to him and his heirs for ever Item I give and bequeath
 to my son Thomas my land that I bought of John Hodgson being 1/2 of Thomas
 Patricks to him and his heirs for ever Item I give and bequeath to my son Samuels my
 land that I bought of Marko Collins being and lying on the side of powder and
 Swamp to him & his heirs for ever, and after my debts are justly payed I give unto
 my well beloved wife the third part of my personall Estate and the remainder of my
 Estate to be Equally Divided amongst my Children, Item I give to my Daughter
 Deborah our Gold ring Item I give to John Harris my Exor that he have no in
 position my will is that my boys Live and Remain with my beloved wife
 till they attain to the age of twenty years and then to be for themselves but not to
 have possession of their Estates till they be twenty one years and my Exors my wife
 is that they Live and remain with my beloved wife till they attain to the age of
 Eighteen years or the full day of marriage but in Case my wife should marry
 another husband and my Children can prove that they are not well used they

then shall have their Liberties logo and Cause their Guardian too hereby I have received
In witness all and every other former Testaments with Legats and Regulators or by
me in any wise before named wished and requested, ratifying and Confirming
this and no other to be my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand this Day and year above written
