 of New London County my trustee and sole ex^r of this my last will
 In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and signed my hand this 29th Day
 of June 1721.

 her heirs for ever: the third I give to my daughter Ann to be delivered to her when —
 it is a year old: and the fourth born Lorde Child I give to my daughter Elizabeth or to be —
 delivered to her at a year old to her and heirs for ever: And the remainder of her —
 issue I give to my daughter Sarah and to her heirs for ever: then I give my negroe —
 boy named to my son Samuels to him and his heirs forever: then I give and bequeath —
 to my son Chiarles my said chard I bought of John Hodgeson being Esq: of Edward —
 Pateshaw to him and his heirs for ever from I give and bequeath to my son Samuels my —
 land that I bought of Matthew Letham being and lying on the side of Newmarket and —
 Swamps to him & his heirs for ever, and after my debts are justly payed I give unto —
 my well beloved wife the third part of my personalty estate and the remainder of my —
 estate to be equally diuided amongst my children, then I give to my daughter —
 Elizabeth one Gold ring from I give to John Harris my sonne that he hath no son —
