In the name of God Amen this 30<sup>th</sup> day of April one thousand Seven hundred & Twenty I W<sup>m</sup> Mitchell being sick and weak in body but of sound & perfect memory praise be given to almighty God for the same & willing to mind the uncertainty of this present life on Earth and being desirous to settle things in order do make this my Last Will & Testament viz First and principally I recommend my Soul into the hands of almighty God hoping thro' the precious Death of my only Saviour & Redeemer Jesus Christ to find pardon & Redemption of all my sins and be saved by Vertue of his precious Death & passion & my body to the Earth from whence it was taken to be buried in such Christian Decent manner as to my Executors or Executor hereafter named shall think meet, and as touching such worldly Estate as the Lord in mercy hath lent me my will & meaning is that the same be employed as hereafter mentioned Reserving Frustrating & making void all wills by me formerly made & do make this to be my Last Will & Testament & none other. In witness whereof I give & bequeare unto my Son W<sup>m</sup> Mitchell Two cows & Calves to be delivered to him at his arrival at the age of Twenty one years, and he lies w<sup>th</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Mitchell his wife & abide w<sup>th</sup> my Loving wife Jane Mitchell until he comes to that age of 21 years also I give & bequeare unto the sd W<sup>m</sup> Mitchell one Shute of Cloth. Further do order that the sd Will Mitchell shall have four year smooching if opportunity presents convenient as soon as he is capable of taking Learning also I do bequeare to him a gun to be delivered at y<sup>e</sup> time of age of 21 years w<sup>th</sup> a proviso that he is to
