taken for my last will & Testament. First I give & bequeath my Soul
to God who gave it, In Trust & certain hopes of a joyfull resur-
rection att y^e last day, through y^e Intercession of my
Blessed Saviour, Jesus Christ & my body to y^e Earth from whence it
was taken, to be buried in such manner as y^e friends & kinsmen
shall see fit. As for my worldly goods I thus bequeath y^e sum of
my wife is y^e all my last bequeath y^e I do owe to any other person
I have & give to my dear & loving wife Katherine Dene, whom
I likewise constitute & ordain my only & sole executrix of
this my last will & Testament, with full power to her to do
as she shall see fit to be enjoyed & disposed and at her disposal for
satisfying & confirming y^e & no other to be my last will &
