 taken for my Last will & Testament. First I give & bequeath my soul
 to God who gave it, In full & certain hopes of a full & resur-
 rection att last day, through the intercession of my
 blessed Saviour, Jesus Christ & my body to my Earth from whence it
 was taken; to be buried in some manner as my time & place will
 afford. & as for my worldly goods I have bequeathed my just debts
 my will is that all my just debts & do owe to any one or more
 whom I give to my dear & loving wife Katherine White whom
 I likewise constitute & ordain my exec & sole Notary of
 this my Last will & Testament in my State bed & chamber
 in her presence to be enjoyed & possessed and at her disposal to be
 satisfied & confirmed & no other is or was my Last will &
 Testament. In witness whereof I have written & set my hand
 & seal this 21st day of July in the year of our Lord 1718 -
